The site will ask you for state abbreviation and password. Enter your two-letter state abbreviation as indicated and your county of residence as the password.

Choose "Legal Information Reference Center."

Click on the first letter of the title you are interested in and scroll down until you find your book:

If you click on a title, you will get an info page on that book. Click on "Full Text" link to get a list of chapters.

Find the chapter you wish to read and click on "PDF Full Text."

You can save the chapter as a PDF using "Download PDF."
